LOCATION

Phoenix Convention Center (PCC) – North Building – [100 N. Third St, Phoenix AZ 85004](#).

- **3rd Street will be closed on Wed, 11/9 in BOTH directions. Drop Off on Monroe, between 3rd and 5th Streets.**

DROP OFF / PARKING / PICK UP

- BUSES/MINI-BUS/ATHLETICS BUS (**OVERSIZED VEHICLES**):
 - Bus Parking / Mini / Athletic – Buses that will stay (**advisers driving and parking oversized**) **Red Arrow**
 - 5:00 PM Bus Pick up – Bottom map **Red Arrow**
 - Bus Drop-off only – On Monroe – eastbound – **Green arrow**
- **Regular/Small sized vehicles: van/district mini-van/car - Less than 7.5 feet in height**
 - **TEXT ME PRIOR TO WEDNESDAY 602.828.0391** – You will park in the parking garage using the entrance on Monroe and 5th Street – look for the **P** on following map – [475 E Monroe St](#). I will text you a parking code to scan to enter and exit. **DO NOT PUSH THE BUTTON FOR A TICKET** or you will have to pay.

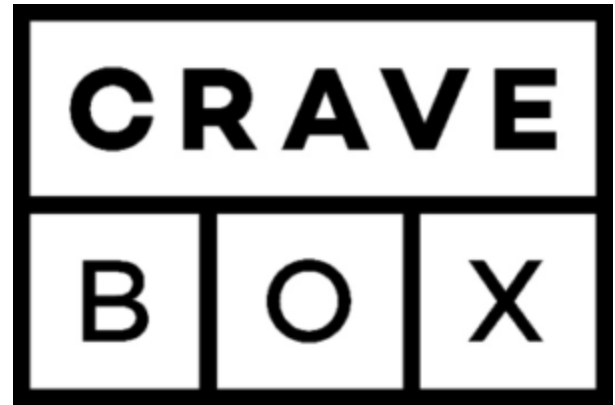


LUNCH VOUCHER OPTIONS AT THE PHOENIX CONVENTION CENTER FOOD COURT

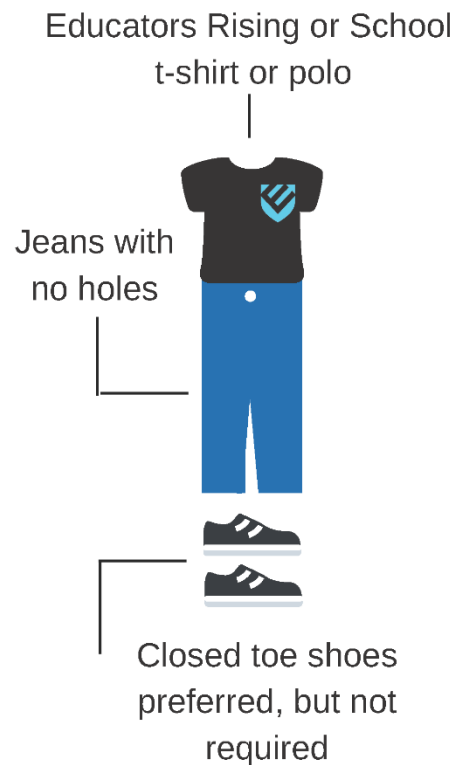
Professional Dress
